CONGRATULATING CHRIS AULT

Mr. HELLER. Madam President, today I wish to congratulate Hall of Fame Nevada football coach Chris Ault on his retirement after 28 seasons coaching the Nevada Wolf Pack football team. Not only has Coach Ault been an unparalleled football coach, but he was also an extremely talented student-athlete at the University of Nevada Reno, UNR, as the Wolf Pack's star quarterback from 1965 to 1967.

Coach Ault was inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame in 2002 after guiding the UNR football program from Division II to Division I-AA to Division I-A. Coach Ault restored championship-caliber football to the University of Nevada by taking the Wolf

Pack to seven straight bowl appearances and two WAC Championships. In 2010, he coached the team to a nearly perfect 13-1 record and finished the season ranked No. 11 in the final top 25 polls. Throughout his career, Coach Ault was named by his peers seven times as the conference's Coach of the Year, and became the 54th coach in NCAA history to win 200 games, and the 30th to win 200 games at one school.

I ask my colleagues to join me in congratulating Coach Chris Ault for a distinguished coaching career in Nevada. It is my hope that he will serve as an example of what great things a person can accomplish when they work with commitment, determination, and persistence.
