
White Pine County, Nevada would like to offer its support of the proposed legislation to facilitate certain pinyon-juniper related projects in Lincoln County, Nevada to modify the boundaries of certain wilderness areas in the White Pine County, and to provide for the implementation of a conservation plan for the Virgin River, Nevada.

White Pine County's specific interest is as follows: "Sec.3. MT. MORIAH WILDERNESS, HIGH SCHELLS WILDERNESS, AND ARC DOME WILDERNESS BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENTS." Mt. Moriah Wilderness: The proposed adjustment to the Mt. Moriah Wilderness Area will allow access to the main road and facilities at the Big Canyon Trailhead which is a main access route to the Table on Mt. Moriah; High Schells Wilderness: The proposed adjustment to the High Schells Wilderness Area will exclude an existing Girl Scout Camp Area from designated Wilderness status. The boundary of the High Schells Wilderness established under subsection (a)(11) is adjusted to include the land identified as 'Include as Wilderness' on the map entitled 'McCoy Creek Adjustment' and dated November 3, 2014 and to exclude the land identified as 'NFS Lands' on the map entitled "Proposed Wilderness Boundary Adjustment High Schells Wilderness Area" and dated June 17, 2014.
